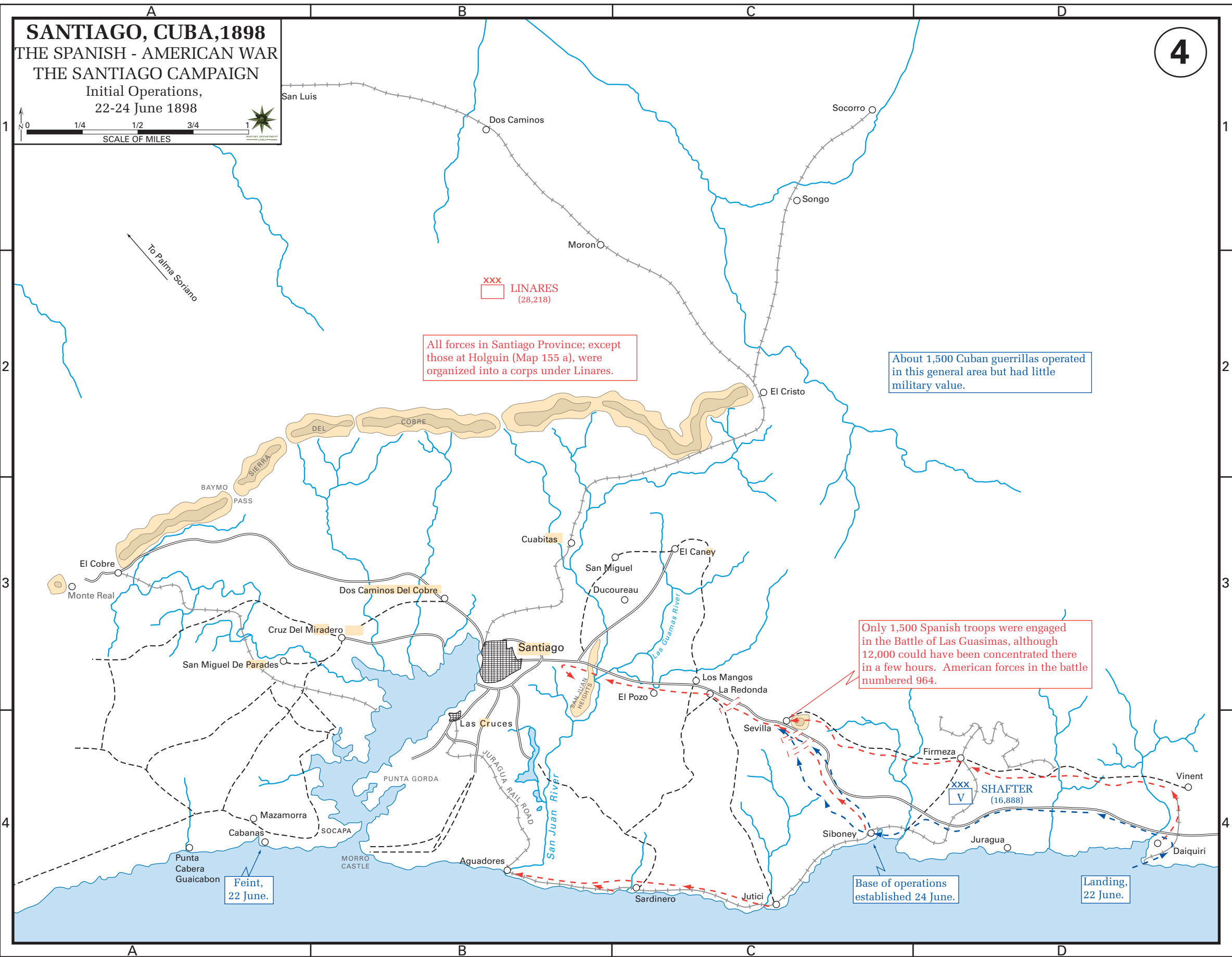


SANTIAGO, CUBA, 1898

All forces in Santiago Province; except those at Holguin (Map 155 a), were organized into a corps under Linares.

About 1,500 Cuban guerrillas operated in this general area but had little military value.

Only 1,500 Spanish troops were engaged in the Battle of Las Guasimas, although 12,000 could have been concentrated there in a few hours. American forces in the battle numbered 964.

Feint, 22 June.

Base of operations established 24 June.

Landing, 22 June.
