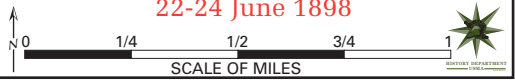

City of Santiago

Most of the guns in these fortifications were obsolete, dating from 1688 to 1783. A few modern guns, taken from a cruiser, had been recently mounted, mostly in Upper Socapa and Punta Gorda batteries.

Symbol  indicates a group of controlled marine mines.

Merrimac was sunk here.
